ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA & CONDITIONS

1. Eligibility criteria for this scholarship

- You need to be a New Zealand citizen or have residency;
- You need to have resided in the Sumner/Ferrymead catchment area (see website for description of the catchment area) during the last 3 years of secondary school;
- You need to be studying for a humanities degree full-time at university;
- You should not have received any other scholarship/awards towards the course fees for the year of study;
- You are not a child or grandchild of a Sumner/Ferrymead Foundation Trustee; and
- You will provide your exam results from 2023.

2. Recipient Responsibilities

- If requested, to attend an interview organised by the Foundation;
- To attend an event during the universities' mid-year break where scholarships being sponsored by the Sumner Ferrymead Foundation and others are presented;
- To provide the Foundation with their exam results and the bank account details into which the money should be paid to claim the scholarship;
- To agree to their name and photograph being used for promotional purposes by the Sumner Ferrymead Foundation and the sponsor of the scholarship; and
- To recognise the receipt of the award, the Sumner Ferrymead Foundation, and the sponsor on their social media.

3. Sumner Ferrymead Foundation Obligations

- To arrange an event to acknowledge all scholarship winners;
- To promote the awards in the Bay Harbour News, on the Foundation's website and via social media;
- To reimburse the scholarship winner on receipt of documentation showing they have passed all courses. If there are extenuating circumstances (accepted by the Foundation), which have resulted in a partial pass, the scholarship may be prorated at the discretion of the Foundation.

4. Decision Making

- Decisions on the awarding of scholarships will be made by the Trustees of the Sumner Ferrymead Foundation;
- Decisions of the Foundation will be final and no correspondence will be entered into concerning the results of the scholarships;
- Decision making will be informed by feedback from any party as appropriate to the individual application/applicant;
- Decision making will be informed by 2023 year exam results, any challenges the applicant may have had to overcome to achieve these grades, and wider community contribution; and

- In the event there is no suitable candidate, no scholarship will be awarded.
